GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

General information for authors

"Engineering and Protection of Environment" journal publishes original research and review papers and also descriptions of new technological and construction solutions in the areas of:

- water supply and sewerage systems,
- water purification and wastewater treatment,
- management of waste and sewage sludge,
- biotechnology,
- protection of soil, water and air,
- controlled combustion of fuels,
- ventilation and air-conditioning,
- monitoring of contaminants in the environment,
- fate and transformation of contaminants in the environment,
- catalysis and environmental nanotechnologies,
- management of environment.

Guidelines for authors

Authors should prepare their manuscripts according to the submission requirements provided by the Editor of the journal:

1. Submissions are received in Polish and in English.

2. It is recommended to prepare submissions in the text editor (doc, docx).

3. The length of the manuscript including the summary, tables and figures should not exceed 12 pages of A4 for research work and 20 pages of A4 for reviews.

4. A manuscript should provide the first and last names of the authors, their affiliations with the addresses should be provided in Polish and in English, email addresses, and the title of the manuscript in Polish and in English,

5. A manuscript in Polish should provide a summary of 200-500 words in Polish and in English with suitable keywords.

6. A manuscript in English should provide a summary in English (a summary in Polish is not mandatory).

7. Figures should be prepared in black and white. Each figure with the captions should not exceed the dimensions of $13 \times 19,5$ cm.

8. Tables in Polish submission should include captions in Polish and in English.
 9. In text references should be provided in the order in which they appear in the

text according to the following examples:

[1] Stumm W., Morgan J.J., Aquatic chemistry, Wiley-Interscience, New York 1981. (authors, a book title, publisher, place and year of publication)

[2] Winnicki T., Inżynieria ochrony środowiska - stan obecny i perspektywy rozwoju, Inż.

i Ochr. Środ. 1998, 1, 1, 7-14. (authors, title of a paper, journal, year, volume, issue, pages)

[3] Kowalik P., Energetyczne wykorzystanie osadów ściekowych w oczyszczalni w Swarzewie,

10. By submitting a manuscript to this journal the authors agree that it will be published in paper and in electronic version.

11. If a manuscript contains any parts from other publications (e.g. figures, tables, etc. protected by copyright) the authors are responsible for obtaining permission to publish these parts in the journal.

12. The authors are also responsible for obtaining permission from their supervisor/organization to publish a manuscript.

13. Authors who come from Poland have to submit the publication payment of 200 PLN+VAT (payments are made after publication) whereas authors from abroad are excluded from this payment.

- In case of any questions or concerns related to the submission process the authors are kindly requested to contact the editors via email <u>jlach@is.pcz.czest.pl</u> or bjablinska@is.pcz.czest.pl
- 3. The authors should also provide:
 a written statement that the manuscript has not been published before and it does not violate existing copyrights, and the authors are familiar with the journal's code of ethics (download file)
 - a signed license agreement (download file).
- 4. Redakcja nie zwraca nadesłanych materiałów.
- 5. Editorial board reserves the rights to introduce changes in submitted manuscripts.

Verification of manuscripts and editorial procedures

- 1. All submitted manuscripts are subject to verification by the Editorial Board (i.e. technical, thematic and language editors).
- To prevent from any violation of academic integrity such as "Ghostwriting" and "Ghost authorship" (Procedures against "Ghostwriting" and "Ghost authorship"), the Editorial Board examines the information about the contribution of each author and co-authors (completed form with the statement and license for manuscript publication).
- 3. A manuscript accepted by the Editorial Board for the revision is sent to two independent reviewers who are acknowledged in a given field or discipline in line with the **reviewing procedure**.
- 4. A manuscript can be scanned and checked for originality by using anyplagiarism software.
- 5. A manuscript is submitted for publication based on the reviewers' recommendations and the decision of the Editorial Board.
- 6. Authors are informed about acceptance or rejection of their manuscript by the Editor-in-Chief.
